REGULAR MEETING MINUTES OF JUNE 25, 2024**

This is a regular scheduled meeting of the Carlstadt Sewerage Authority being held at Carlstadt Sewerage Authority, 429 Hackensack Street, Carlstadt, New Jersey.

Chairman D. Ravettine called the regularly scheduled June 25, 2024, meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Meadowlands Rebuild – NJDEP has provided easement and mapping information to NEA. NJDEP has satisfied the NEA review comments regarding the mapping and easement description.

810 Washington Avenue – The Applicant has requested a “will serve” letter. No change.

284 Washington Avenue – Lateral (sanitary sewer) is connected to CSA System but is not operational.

463 Barrel Avenue – The Applicant has installed sewer improvements, which are at variance with the CSA review comments. The Applicant’s Contractor has met with NEA representative on or about April 25, 2024. The Contractor has stated that he will comply with the CSA review comments. The CSA has removed an obstruction in the CSA sewer and the Applicant will clean and inspect the downstream sewer.

245 Paterson Plank Road – Connection complete. Applicant has completed the service connection. The Applicant’s sewer video and report revealed several significant downstream defects in the CSA Sewer. (Located separate for the Applicant’s service connection work).

333 Washington Avenue

The Applicant’s dewatering operations, which include the discharge treated groundwater generated on site into the existing CSA Interceptor commenced on Tuesday, October 24, 2023. Discharge of treated Groundwater into the CSA Interceptor is metered, and sewage rates and service charges will be billed to the Applicant.

GW discharge to CSA System has briefly resumed. The GW discharge to the CSA System was curtailed due to the Easement issue.

The Applicant has commenced the construction of the CSA Interceptor on Monday, November 13, 2023.

The Applicant has received a NJSEA Permit for the work in the CSA Easement on the 401 Washington Avenue property. Bypass pumping operation commenced on Monday, June 17, 2024, and is scheduled to be completed on Tuesday, June 25, 2024.

130 Moonachie Avenue (Jurisdiction): Based on initial field inspections and the Applicant's Site Plan sanitary sewage generated from the site appears to discharge to the CSA Sewerage System. The Applicant has been requested to clean and remove obstruction from an on-site manhole.

111, 135, 140 Kero Rd: Additional information request from the Applicant's Engineer to clarify the application.

640 Gotham Pkwy Lateral: The original Contractor was unable to excavate to the required depth. The Owner is seeking a new contractor for the project.
